Old/New Business

- Ridgeview at Stetson Hills – The final draft of the landscape maintenance agreement was approved by Darsey Nicklasson and sent to Jill Nissen from Diversified. Jill expressed to Kristie she is having trouble getting Ridgeview board to sign the agreement. Kristie is going to the Ridgeview board meeting next week to talk directly with the board.
- Gates – The gates need additional safety loops installed. Automatic Access estimates for the work is \$1925.00. Kristie is to check whether that includes patching the asphalt and how long the work will take.
- Reflective items - All but two have been installed. The Sign Shop will add missing reflectors when in Sand Creek area.
- Dog Poop Stations – After board discussion it was concluded that dog poop stations would not be added. Responsible dog owners are already picking up after their dogs.
- Insect spray – With the wet season insects could become a problem. The board is in agreement that if insects do affect the vegetation they should be sprayed, cost to be e-mailed to the Board at time needed.
- Landscape contractor – Board discussion on the three contractors submitting bids for landscape maintenance contract. Richard motioned to accept ValleyCrest as the landscape contractor, Kim seconded; motion carried. Kristie will set up walk with Richard, ELM, Kristie, and ValleyCrest to begin the landscape turn over process.
